Dear Paddle Passholder:

The 2004-2005 paddle tennis season has been a huge success for Hinsdale and all those that participate in the sport. The lesson program, league play and other social programs initiated by the newly formed Hinsdale Paddle Tennis Association are all being well received.

The Burr Ridge residents east of the new courts at Katherine Legge Memorial Park (KLM) have expressed their concern on the new court lighting and noise that is generated from the courts. In response to this, we would ask your cooperation so that we can keep our relationship with the neighbors on a positive note. Please abide by the following:

- The KLM court lights are to be turned off by 10:30 p.m. If you are playing late in the evening, please move to the west courts and turn off the east court lights.
- Excessive shouting and use of vulgarity cannot be tolerated.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the warming house and in the Park.

Officials from the Village of Burr Ridge on behalf of the KLM area residents and King-Bruwaert House have asked that the Village of Hinsdale again consider an earlier shut-off time for the court lights. The matter has been referred to the Park and Recreation Commission to discuss at their February 21, 2005 meeting. The meeting will be held in the Memorial Hall of the Hinsdale Memorial Building beginning at 7:00 p.m.
